On February 19, 2020 at 10:56 pm, Dallas officers were dispatched to a hit and run crash in the 300 Block of SE Hankel Street. When Officer Andrew Taylor arrived, a black sedan parked on the street had its bumper torn off, lying in pieces on the ground. The trunk of the sedan had been pushed into the rear seat, and the trunk lid was forced open exposing its contents. The victim's sedan was pushed into another one of their vehicles which was also parked on the street. Pieces believed to be from the suspect's vehicle were located on the ground at the scene.

Officer Jordan Schrock arrived and assisted, tracking a fluid trail presumably left behind by the suspect vehicle. Schrock followed the trail and ultimately located the suspect vehicle, which had front end damage consistent with the damage at the scene.

Officer Schrock made contact with the suspect and took her into custody. She was lodged at the Polk County Jail, charged with DUII/Alcohol, Reckless Driving, and Fail to Perform Duties of a Driver when Property is Damaged. The breath test resulted in a blood alcohol concentration of more than four times the legal limit.
