Accessibility

Downtown Salem, the state capitol, is only 20 minutes away. State highways connect Dallas to the surrounding region, including the Salem and Portland metropolitan areas. Interstate 5 is approximately 20 miles away. Portland International Airport is 70 miles away, and Salem Municipal Airport is 18 miles away. In addition, Dallas has rail access.

• Skilled Work Force

Our businesses have access to a growing, well-educated, and highly-skilled local and regional work force. Job training programs are also available through the state and Chemeketa Community College and the Dallas School District's growing Career and Technical Education programs.

Available Land

We have vacant acreage and buildings suitable for a variety of businesses, from large manufacturing firms to small service businesses. Some of these properties are eligible for property tax exemptions through our Enterprise Zone, as well as the capital gains tax reinvestment benefits of the Dallas Opportunity Zone.
